This is a significant problem.

If you're the only person making entries, you can fix this by using " for double quotes, ‘ for left single quotes and apostrophes, and ’ for right single quote.

However, i imagine the majority of the people who use this component are not the only people entering in events. I know that some users modify the language file to easily turn the program into a comment system, in which case, the method of getting rid of the quotes that i listed above in this post would not be realistic.

Will someone find the reason it puts the slashes in? (i imagine its php trying to escape it and doing it wrong somewhere but i can't find it)
